The project is being carried out in four regions (federal states) and is coordinated and scientifically supported by the JKI.

## Your responsibilities

- development of a concept for the scientific evaluation of the implementation of measures;
- carrying out scientific analyses with regard to economic, climate protection/climate adaptation and ecological criteria at measure, farm and regional level as well as across regions;
- application of suitable parameters and indicators, realisation of case studies and collection of necessary data, identification of drivers, obstacles and conflicting objectives;
- organization and implementation of data management for the project;
- consolidating findings and results and preparing them for knowledge transfer;
- close cooperation and exchange with all project partners;
- reporting, including the preparation of status reports, scientific as well as practice-related publications;
- presentation of project results at project meetings as well as national and international conferences.

## Your profile

- a completed academic university degree (at least a master's degree, university diploma, or comparable qualification) in agricultural, horticultural, earth or environmental sciences or a comparable discipline;
- extensive knowledge of vegetable field crop production including current challenges and future options for action;
- knowledge and experience in scientific analyses and the determination of suitable parameters and indicators in at least one of the above-mentioned areas (economy, climate, ecology) related to arable farming;
- experience in collecting data and conducting surveys as well as good data management skills;
- experience in working with partners in practice (farms and advisory organisations);
- very good organisational and communication skills, a high level of initiative, independence, flexibility, resilience and the ability to work in a team;
- very good written and spoken communication skills, especially in German and English;
- a class B (III) driving licence, a willingness to drive a company car and travel on business trips lasting several days.
